Drinks: Some wine and sparkling water.

Menu: Kimbap (Sea weed roll- vegetarian and meat option)



There are “Speaker” and “Listener” in this game. The ‘Speaker’ tells something about them self for 5 minutes. At the end of the turn, the ‘Listener’ decides if the story sounds like a lie or truth.



If the ‘Listener’ thinks it is a lie, the ‘Speaker’ moves to the blanket on the right and they become a ‘Listener’ in the next round.

The ‘Listener’ moves to the blanket to the top, and they become a ‘Speaker’ in the next round. If it sounds like a truth, the opposite rule is applied.



The rules are devised in a way that players can meet a new person every turn, and everyone gets a chance to tell something or nothing about themselves.

The game is an opportunity to talk to strangers, without the usual stress of honesty and sincerity. In the end, everything discussed in the game could either be truth or lie.
